THIS IS MY SON, THE BELOVED

It may seem strange, but this is a Christmas Feast. Not if we think of Christmas only in terms of the Baby in Bethlehem, but if we have followed the ideas of the Feasts of Holy Family and especially Epiphany, and have seen the Season in terms of the growing manifestation or appearing of the Son of God: first to the shepherds and then to the wise men from the East. Now in the River Jordan, Jesus, Son of Mary, is revealed to all as the fullness of all God's promises: "This is my Son, the Beloved".

On this day we stand before the revelation of God's love for us, such that he would send his only Son into the world. Christmas without the Baptism of the Lord, and the words that are spoken from heaven, would be incomplete, since it is only in them that we fully see the wonder of what happened in Bethlehem. As we come to the end of Christmas today, and look forward to hearing the Gospels in Ordinary Time, we do so having been shown who it is we listen to: the only Son of God, the Beloved. A Urafiki wish for Christmas 2024





Dear Urafiki supporters, many of you have been asking if we are having a Christmas appeal this year. We would like to raise money for mattresses and blankets for primary and secondary school students. Supporting a child's school fees is a wonderful gift – but if they can't get a good night's sleep, they can struggle to concentrate at school.

Many children live in extreme poverty. Food is scarce, and they sleep on the floor covered in rags. Blankets are shared with siblings and so they wear out quickly as a result of all the 'tugging', when children are trying to stay warm at night. The photos below show the conditions such a family live in.

A simple foam mattress and a blanket gives the prospect of a good night's sleep. Mattresses cost £15 each. Blankets cost £5 each. If you can help in any way, we would be most grateful, but no pressure. A direct payment to the Urafiki bank account avoids any charges and is preferable.
